Rules

1. Hours of operation are from 8:30 am until dark. Gates will be closed and locked for security during non-business hours. Please call Cliff Swain at 858-539-9310 if you need emergency entrance to the facility.
2. The arenas will be dragged and watered in the mornings Monday through Saturday.
3. A mailbox is available outside of the office for check payments if a payment is not mailed before the 1st of the month. Payment will be late if it is not in the mailbox after dark on the 5th of the month and late fees will then apply.
4. The Farm at Del Mar Meadows is a non-smoking/non-alcoholic facility.
5. Drive *Slowly* (5 mph or less) around the ranch property. There is no parking or driving in the center aisle.
6. The office is for staff only unless invited into the office. Please do not enter or use office phone or equipment.
7. Dogs must be leashed or penned while on the property. No dobermans, rottwilers or pitbulls will be allowed on the property.
8. Two turnout and round pen areas are available on a first come, first serve basis for 20-30 minutes maximum. No unattended turnouts are allowed.

9. Turnouts are not allowed in either of the arenas. All turnouts should be done in round pens and specified turn out areas.
10. Horses should either be tied to hitching posts or on cross ties. They may not be tied up on trailers.
11. All grain must be in sealed trashcans with bungee securing lids. Grain trashcans must be in designated areas and are not allowed inside the tack houses.
12. All private parties and picnics must be discussed with the manager so conflicts don't arise. All reasonable effort will be made to allow these get together's.
13. Parking is only allowed in designated areas. Warnings will be given if parking is not done in an acceptable manner and will be grounds for eviction should this become a problem.
14. All additional services needed for a particular day should to be set up in advance with a 24-hour notice. Same day services may not be available.
15. Trash is expected to be picked up at all times.
16. Children when not in lessons must be supervised by a trainer while on the property at all times. Parents are responsible to pick up their child on time.
17. No child under 18 can ride unsupervised.
18. Helmets must be worn by all minors under the age of 18 while on a horse. Appropriate footwear "boots" should be worn for riding. Dress code includes t-shirts and polo shirts. Spaghetti straps or midriffs are not acceptable.
19. Anyone riding a horse on the property must sign a release of liability even if it is a guest of the horse owner.

20. This facility participates in neighborhood fly prevention. Solitude is used during season to prevent excessive flies. For further information contact Cliff Swain.
